

# **Post-Doctoral Fellowship Schizophrenia Division Complex Care and Recovery (CCR) Program**

## **Position Description**

The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) is the largest mental health and addiction teaching hospital in Canada, as well as one of the world's leading research centres in its field. Our goal is to tailor treatment to each individual, providing patient-centered, comprehensive, coordinated care. Research in the Schizophrenia Division is focused on diverse interests, including clinical treatment trials, metabolic health, virtual reality, brain imaging, digital health, genetics and health services research.

CAMH is seeking a full-time Post-Doctoral Fellow (for 6 months) to support the Culturally Adapted Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) for Canadians of South Asian Origin Research Study. This multi-center, multi-phase study funded by Health Canada is the first project of its kind in Canada and includes a qualitative component and randomized controlled trial. The goal of this study is to develop and evaluate culturally adapted CBT (CaCBT) for South Asian populations with depression and anxiety in Canada, taking the first step towards developing evidence-based interventions that are equitable, accessible and culturally-appropriate.

In this role, the candidate will be directly supervised by the principal investigator of the study, Dr. Farooq Naeem. The successful candidate will be responsible for preparing databases, analyzing data, writing reports, collaborating with stakeholders, and supporting the research team in completing project deliverables. The fellow will be expected to play a significant role in the preparation of Health Canada deliverables related to end-of-project milestones.

An interest and experience in cultural aspects of mental health and working with diverse communities is essential. The candidate should have proven experience in data analysis, report-writing, preparing manuscripts, conducting literature reviews and systematic reviews. The individual will support a healthy workplace that embraces diversity, encourages teamwork, and complies with all applicable CAMH policies, as well as all regulatory and legislative requirements. This position is located at 33 Ursula Franklin Street.

## **Qualifications**

- Possess a PhD in the field of psychology, mental health, social and behavioural sciences or a related field
- Experience conducting quantitative (SPSS, R) and qualitative (NVivo) research is preferred
- Ability to multitask and produce high-quality, accurate work while meeting deadlines.
- Must be detail-oriented, well-organized, and work well independently and in a team
- Excellent written communication skills, and ability to write effective, high-quality reports and manuscripts for publication
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal, and oral communication skills
- Bilingualism (French/English) would be an asset
